A lightly coloured version printed on a semi-transparent fabric providing privacy without blocking the daylight and a dark version printed on a slightly textured, transparent fabric which softly filters the light.

- the calming effect of the soothing, neutral colour tones



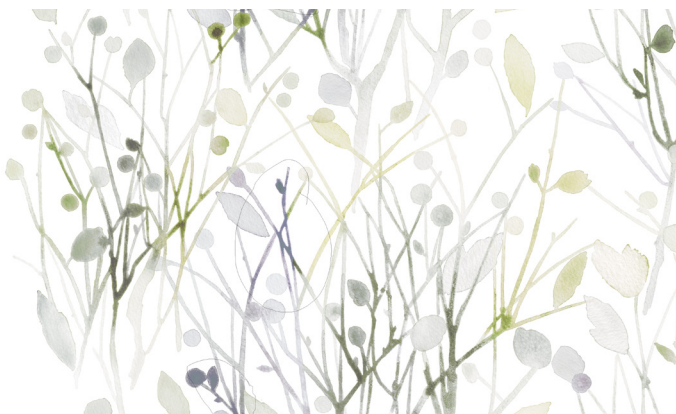
